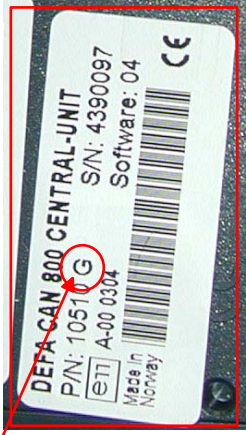

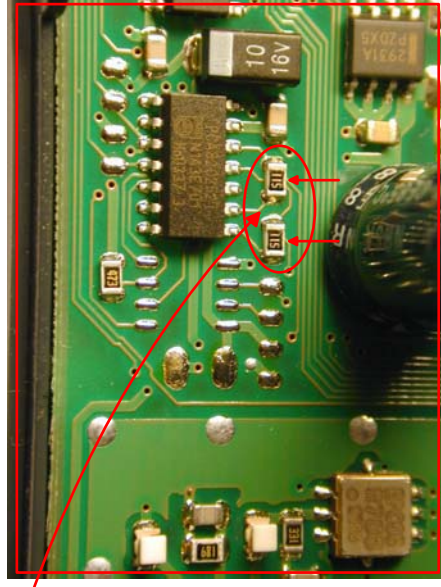

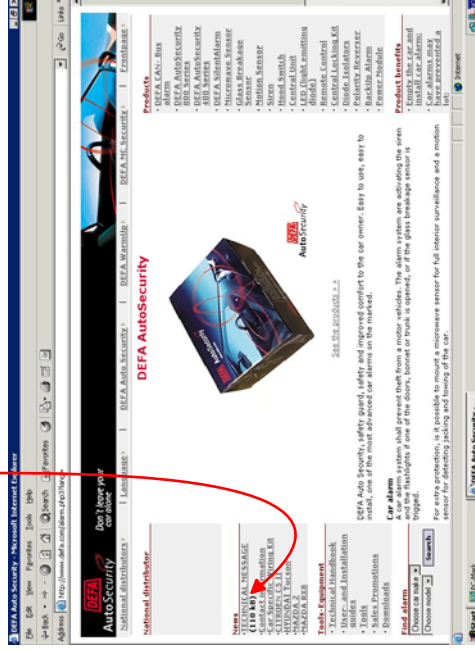
Some F alarm central units have entered the marked as G-versions. Open the G central unit to decide the real version of the central unit.

Have a look at the marking of the resistors on the picture below. Marking:

511 => ~~F~~-version. Follow the installation description for the F-version on the following pages.
332 => G-version. Follow the installation description for the G-version on the following pages.

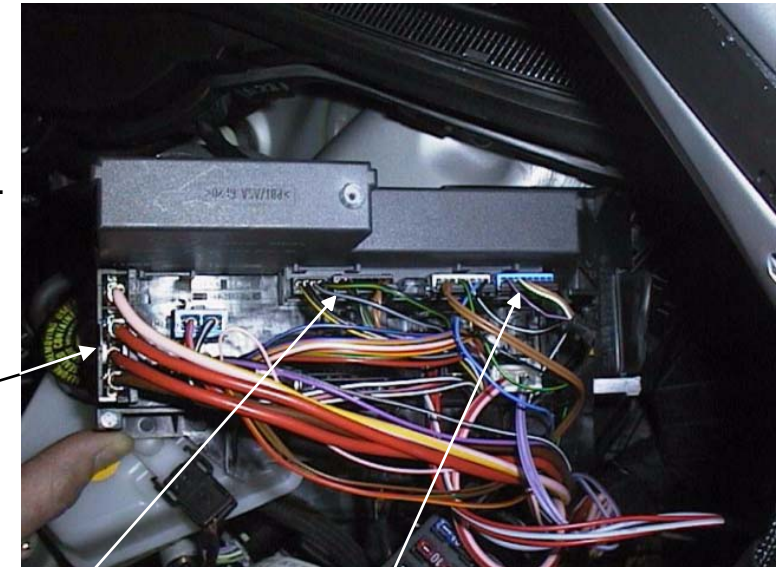

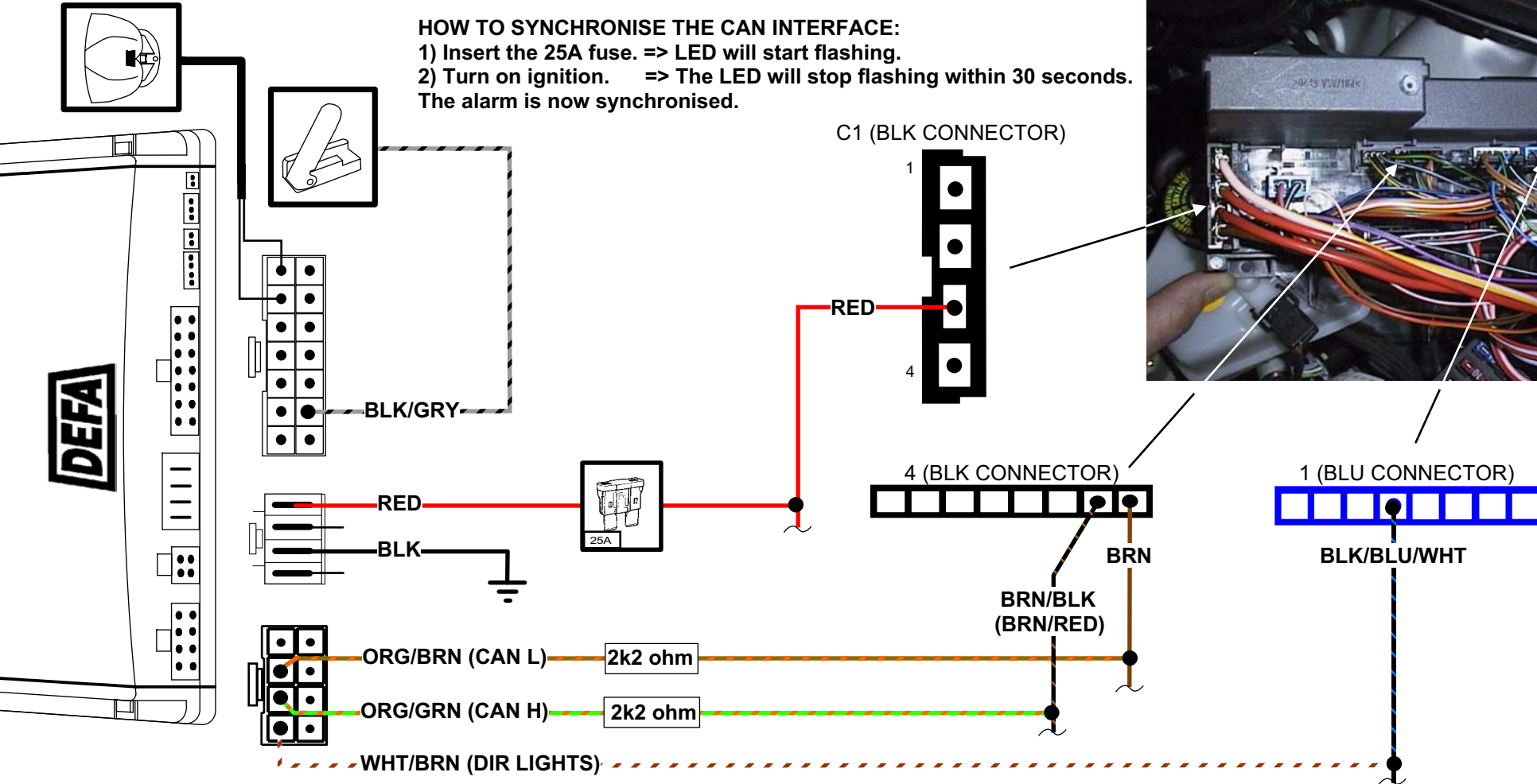

HOW TO SYNCHRONISE THE CAN INTERFACE:

- 1) Insert the 25A fuse. => LED will start flashing.
- 2) Turn on ignition. => The LED will stop flashing within 30 seconds. The alarm is now synchronised.
