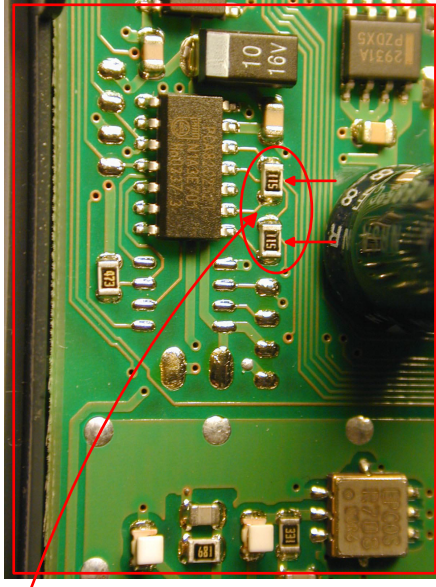
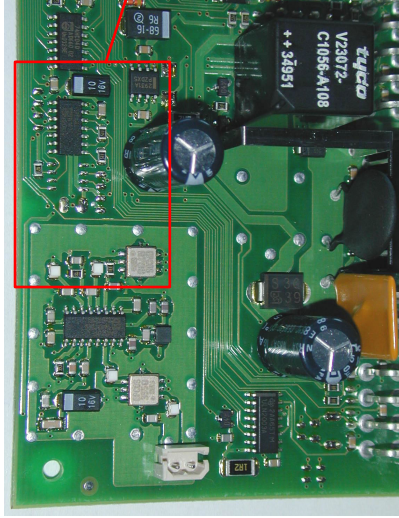


Some F alarm central units have entered the market as G-versions. Open the G central unit to decide the real version of the central unit.

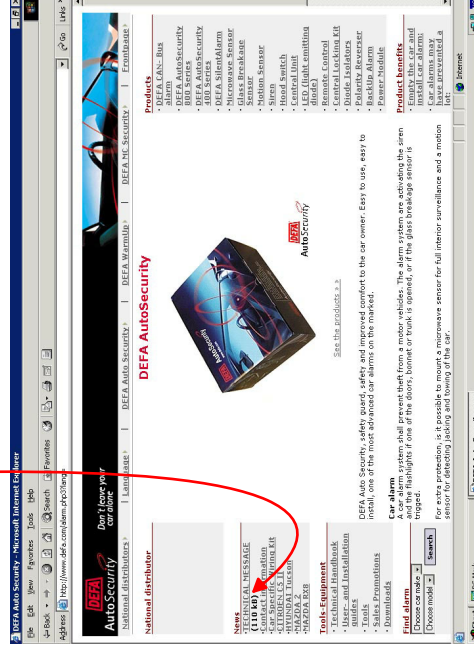
